Capital Health's Stroke and Cerebrovascular Center of NJ recently became the first hospital in Southern/Central New Jersey and the Philadelphia region to treat a patient using a new, experimental stroke device designed to remove blood clots preventing blood from flowing to the brain. Dr. Erol Veznedaroglu, director of Neurosciences and Cerebrovascular & Endovascular Neurosurgery at Capital Health used the device as part of the SWIFT study (Solitaire™ FR with the Intention for Thrombectomy). Capital Health is one of only ten hospitals in the country to have treated a patient as part of the study.
