Please take a minute to look at some of the carnival highlights that are featured in this newsletter. We hope you can set some time aside on your calendars on July 26 – 29 to join us.

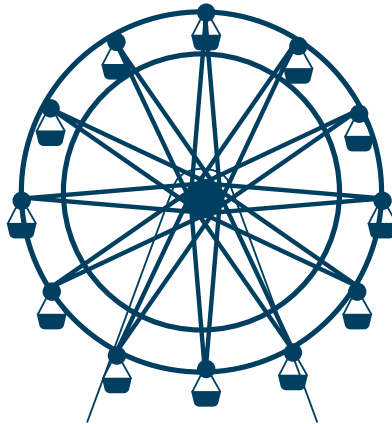
We look forward to sunny skies and the opportunity to share four days of fun and friendship with our Capital Health family and our community neighbors.

## STEP RIGHT UP AND JOIN THE FUN!

### PARKING & TRANSPORTATION

Free parking will be available at Capital Health Medical Center - Hopewell (Lot B – Employee Parking Area). Shuttle service will be provided to and from the carnival at Woolsey Park.

Limited on-site parking at the Woolsey Park carnival site will be available for a \$5 fee. Paid parking will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. On-site parking will also be available for free for those with handicap needs (handicap license plate or sticker will be required to park on-site).

If you are only dropping off/picking up passengers at the carnival, you can drive directly to Woolsey Park.

Unlimited-ride wristbands will be offered ALL DAYS and SATURDAY from 6 – 10 p.m. for \$30 (pre-sale price of \$25 if purchased at **campys.com**).

## STEP RIGHT UP AND JOIN THE FUN!

We have something for everyone with water games, thrilling rides, hotdogs, funnel cakes and monster slides! Our carnival will feature 14 rides of all intensity levels and 10 games to test your luck. Here is a sampling of some of the fun that we have planned for you!



### RIDES

**Ferris Wheel** — Everyone knows and loves the Ferris wheel. It is a simple ride that for children is a thrilling experience and for couples a romantic journey. The view from the 45-foot Ferris wheel is unparalleled by any of the other rides. This ride is a great way to scout out the other rides and games you wish to enjoy, or reflect back on a magical night.

**Fun Slide** — This huge slide gives riders a great view of the festivities as they swiftly and gently sweep down the slide. This is a great choice for young riders who want something a bit more intense but aren't ready for the big kid rides yet.

**Frog Hopper** — The Frog Hopper lifts you up into the sky and then bounces you down safely back to earth. It is a vertical-ascent and bounced-descent amusement ride that provides fun for up to seven riders. Everyone will want to hop along with the troupe of brightly colored tropical frogs as they catch flies buzzing about their lily pond in the rain forest.

**Elephants** — Taking off at a carnival near you is the flying elephant! As the ride begins to rotate slowly, the arms lift the giant elephant-themed cars into the air.

**Gravitron** — Step aboard the Gravitron, one of the hottest thrill rides in the nation! Riders stand against the wall inside the giant space ship and centrifugal force lifts them off the floor.

**Ring of Fire** — The Ring of Fire takes riders on an upside-down thrill ride as they race to 60 feet above the ground on this 360-degree looping roller coaster. Riders are safely secured with over-the-shoulder restraints and industrial locking seat belts.

**Scrambler** — The Scrambler whirls riders in circular motions, providing them with a dizzying experience! As the center of the ride spins, the attached satellite spindles rotate as well!



### FOOD

If you're hungry during your visit, stop by vendor row to enjoy delicious carnival fare! With a variety of food vendors being featured at our carnival, you'll have no problem finding something to satisfy your cravings. Make sure to visit the Auxiliary's very own "Capital Grill!"



## GAMES

**Cow Derby** — Cow Derby is a competitive skill-based race. Players must quickly but accurately roll balls into holes. As they do this, their corresponding cow will MOOve forward based on what hole they hit. The first cow to the finish line wins a prize. The more competitors there are, the bigger the prize.

**Water Gun Fun** — In water gun fun, players test their speed and accuracy as they attempt to hit a rotating target with a jet of water. First player whose target rings the bell wins!

**Sharp Shooter** — A true test of skill and accuracy, Sharp Shooter gives its players a cork gun and challenges them to hit three or more targets with only five shots. The more targets you hit the greater your reward.

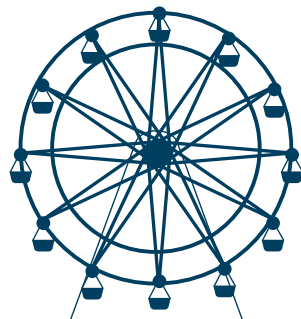
