While all donations are appreciated, the items listed below cannot be accepted. Disposal of these items increases expenses and therefore decreases the amount that we will have to support the Capital Health Auxiliary and their initiatives. Items the store will not accept:

Auto: Parts, tires

Baby: Cribs, mattresses, car seats

Books: Magazines, encyclopedias, text books, instruction manuals, yearbooks, paperbacks

Current novels and cookbooks will be accepted

Building Materials: Paint, carpet remnants

Disposable and Expiration Sensitive: Food, personal care items, household cleaners, fragrances, lotions, makeup, gas cylinders

**Durable Medical Equipment** 

Any item in unsalable condition: Stained, torn, old, mildew, missing pieces, broken

Electronics: Old style televisions, computer towers and old style monitors, large appliances, VCRs

Exercise Equipment: Treadmills, stationary bikes, rowing machines, elliptical machines

Household Items: Mugs, old style luggage, artificial flowers, chandeliers, grills, mattresses, bed pillows, rugs, VCR tapes

Large household items accepted only with prior approval from store manager. Ceiling fans accepted if new and in boxes

Sports Equipment: Golf clubs, bikes, skis, safety helmets, bats, bowling balls

Weapons (bow and arrow, hunting knife, etc)
