MBI can detect certain types of breast cancer much sooner, which can make all the difference, particularly in women with dense breast tissue or those with high risk factors. We also offer digital mammography with same-day results, as well as ultrasound and breast MRI.

A team of specialists intensely focused on your care.

The Center offers a full range of breast care, from cancer to cysts, abscesses, lesions, breast pain and other breast-related disorders. You'll be cared for by a multidisciplinary team that collaborates closely to develop your plan of care. Depending on the nature of your problem, that team could include a breast surgeon, radiologist, medical oncologist, radiation oncologist, plastic surgeon, rehabilitation services, and more.

Genetic and High Risk Assessments

If you are concerned about a family history of breast cancer, our Cancer Genetics Risk Assessment Program can relieve anxiety and provide a sense of control by providing accurate information about cancer risk, cancer screening, and genetic testing. Our High Risk Breast Cancer Program helps women understand what it means to be at high risk and how to manage the risk factors. If you are identified as having a high risk for developing breast cancer, our nurse navigator works with you to identify a specialist who can determine the best way to manage your risk.

A personal nurse navigator to guide you.

Patients diagnosed with breast cancer are assigned a personal breast health navigator. This specially trained oncology nurse will be by your side through every phase of treatment. She'll answer your questions, help you understand your breast cancer treatment plan, facilitate communication between you and your physicians, and provide ongoing support.
