At Capital Health, we provide the most comprehensive LUNG SCREENING AND CANCER TREATMENT PROGRAM in the region through a multidisciplinary team approach, which includes doctors, nurses and other expert healthcare professionals.

Our Lung CT Screening Program is supported by the high quality services offered at our Center for Oncology, located at the Capital Health Medical Center – Hopewell. This includes the most cutting edge diagnostics, specifically our extremely low-dose 128- and 256-slice CT (computerized tomography) scans (LDCT).

There is no contrast involved and no blood tests required, therefore, no needles are used. The actual CT screening takes less than 10 seconds to complete.

Why should someone be screened?

Most lung cancer patients are diagnosed in a late stage of the disease. A CT scan can detect a small nodule making it possible to diagnose lung cancer at an earlier stage and increase the likelihood for a successful outcome.

Who should be screened?

At Capital Health, anyone who wants to get screened may do so if they have a history of smoking and no apparent symptoms. Those at higher risk for cancer may include people ages 55 – 74 who have a heavy smoking history. This includes people who still smoke or have quit within the past 15 years. If you're unsure whether you qualify, please call our nurse navigator.

What do you need for the screening?

A prescription that we will provide for you to bring to your primary care physician.

What is the cost of the screening?

Capital Health offers CT scans for \$99 (insurance does not cover this).



WHERE WILL THE SCREENING TAKE PLACE?

Our Lung CT Screening Program is offered at Capital Health Medical Center – Hopewell.

Our state-of-the-art facility provides free valet parking access to amenities (including the Oasis Spa, concierge services, multiple places to eat, and free wireless internet access), and a soothing environment that includes fireplace settings and a beautifully landscaped rooftop garden.
