Now, Capital Health will use the Mercer cam-

pus for emergency room. and primary care services will be offered by Capital Health Family Medicine-Trenton at 433 Bellevue Ave. across the street from Mercer.

Free shuttle service will be provided for employees, mobile patients and visitors who do not have their own transportation to the Hopewell campus. Shuttles will depart from 433 Bellevue Ave. to the main entrance at Hopewell every hour between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. seven days per week.

The new hospital sits on 165 acres of property in Hopewell Township di-rectly off Interstate 95 at the Scotch Road exit.

Capital Health Regional Medical Center, also lo-cated in Trenton, remains open, featuring \$100 million in renovations being completed this year.
