Magazine Collection: 1 Hour of Volunteer Service Hours for 10 Magazines

We always have a need for current magazines for our patients. Current magazines in any language are greatly appreciated. Magazines should be **no older than 3 months old**. **NOT Accepted:** Store circulars, coupon books, TV Guides, inappropriate magazines for adult audiences only, advertisements, and community circulars/advertisements. Remove address labels with personal identification information to protect the privacy of the donor. (Do not *cross out* – please remove or cut address label).

Cards for Patients: 1 hour of Volunteer Service Hours for 20 cards

Create cards for special occasions – Birthdays; Holidays; Thank you; Thinking of you. Staff will deliver them on the appropriate day. We will not be able to distribute cards with glitter so **no glitter please**! Please **Do Not** write your last name or any personal identifying information – just your first name and your group/organization name (if applicable)

Knitter Program:

3 hours of Volunteer Service Hours - Hats, Mittens & Scarves.6 hours of Volunteer Service Hours - Kids & Lap blankets.10 hours Volunteer Service Hours - Adult blankets.

We have copies of pattern instructions to take home and samples to view at our volunteer office if you need.

Cookie Donation Program:

- **Drop Off** Snacks can be dropped off in the "**Cookie Program Bin**" located in our Volunteer Services Department on the lower level of the Hopewell Campus.
- **Update Donation Sheet** Please drop off the cookies and update the donation sheet with the drop off details so we can account for your donation.
- Accepted Only Prepackaged store bought cookies, granola bars, individual sized boxes of raisins, or packages of pretzels and fish crackers.

- **Not Accepted** Due to allergy concerns, cookies or other snacks containing peanut butter or nuts cannot be accepted.
- Monetary donations can also be sent for the purchase of snacks. Please make checks payable to the "Capital Health Auxiliary" with cookie program written in the memo section.
